MEDIEVAL ALICANTE (Code: ALIAJ)



Combining history with entertainment, castles and ancient towns, this half-day excursion through the Spanish countryside is an introduction to medieval Spain. Leaving the port of Alicante, a 45-minute coach drive will take you to the town of Biar, located at the foot of the Sierra de Mariola. Follow your guide along the streets of the city and explore the streets and squares of Villa Historica followed by a visit to Biar Castle. Information about the castle dates back as far as the Muslim rule, although the fortress only began to have a certain military importance from 1200 onwards and was included in the list of historical and artistic monuments in 1931. After the visit, the excursion continues with a coach drive to the town of Villena, dominated by its imposing castle. Follow your guide on a visit to this fortress, which has a concentric layout, with an inner and higher line of walls forming a square, and with a rectangular barbican forming a larger inner space in front of the imposing keep. The tour also includes a stop to taste typical Spanish pinxos, a regional version of tapas before starting your journey back to Alicante and your ship.

Please note: as the tour involves walking on uneven ground in the towns and at the castles, guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Guests with any type of food intolerance are required to communicate it to the Shore Excursions Office at least two days before the call. Guests will be required to return their audio guide equipment to their tour guide in perfect condition at the end of the tour. Guests will be charged for any damage to or loss of audio guide equipment. Guests need to wear the mask all the time. NOVELDA & WINE TASTING (Code: ALIAF)



Enjoy a pleasant walking tour through the Main Street and narrow "callejuelas" of Alicante for external viewing of some of Alicante's most important monuments including the Town Hall and Con-Cathedral of San Nicolás. Take your camera ready for some nice shots for your memory book before boarding your coach for a 45-minute coach drive to Novelda. Located in the south of Valencia region, the city is famous for its vineyards and for receiving many awards for their constant search for the quality of its wines. You will soon recognize the Modernist or "Art Nouveau" architectural style as you visit the monastery of Santa María Magdalena, a church designed by a disciple of Antoni Gaudí, a true, artistic masterpiece. After the visit, your second part of the tour will include a visit to the wine cellars and a tasting of 2 kinds of wine. Take your time to buy one or two bottles for your dearest before boarding your coach back to Alicante.

Please note: as the tour involves walking on uneven ground, it is unsuitable for guests with walking difficulties. ELCHE & HUERTO DEL CURA (Code: ALIAH)



A short drive to the south of Alicante and just a little inland from the Costa Blanca coastline lies Elche, a Spanish city noted particularly for its abundance of palm groves, one of which is the Huerto del Cura. After an enjoyable coach ride to the city, your sightseeing tour will first take you past Elche's major landmarks before you pay the amazing Huerto del Cura a visit. Providing dappled shade in which to walk and savour the surroundings, this municipal garden is home to a wide variety of tropical and Mediterranean plants, including the seven-fronded "Imperial Palm", which was named after the Empress Elisabeth of Austria, or Sisi, as she was affectionately known. The return drive to Alicante then ends your tour.

Please note: as the tour involves walking on uneven ground at the gardens, guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. BENIDORM ON YOUR OWN (Code: ALI07)

Leave the ship for a 45-minute coach drive to Benidorm, a coastal town known for its hotel industry, beaches, and skyscrapers. Often referred to as the "New York of the Mediterranean" Benidorm is the city with the most skyscrapers per inhabitant in the world and per square meter second only to New York. You will have approx. 2.5 hours to spend as you like it. In spite of being a modern city, Benidorm has much to offer. You can explore the old part, Tossal de la Cala, pay a visit to the Church of Saint James and Anne, dating back to 1740, take a walk along its many famous beaches, reach the viewpoints for a look over the city or look for a souvenir. You will have enough time to visit the city at your pace before joining the coach again for the return back to Alicante and your ship. Please note: The bus stops near "Avda del Mediterráneo"; this is the point of arrival and departure of your tour.


